Minutes of the College Curriculum Committee Meeting

November 16, 2017

Meeting called to order at 3:16.

Agenda approved with the removal of ITL 400. No additions to the agenda.

Approval of minutes from previous meeting on 10/19/2017.

Associate Dean's Remarks

Update on Russian Teaching Minor.

UCC Updates

Stuart Blythe on behalf of Bump Halbritter UCC November 2, 2017 meeting: Spanish secondary changes approved [SPN 420&432], Adding FLT807, LLT 307 was approved. Clarification requested for AFR 302A missing AFR 301A as prerequisite; Associate Dean to follow up with Department.

Curricular Requests

AAAS MNUN: Glenn Chambers explains changes to AAAS minor as creating two tracks for social sciences and the humanities (and removed inactive/sunset courses). This change includes intro course and capstone course. Changes to AAAS MNUN were approved, but on the approved course list there was a suggestion to remove WRAC 125, ENG 317 and add PHL351.

AL BA & BFA Graduation Requirements: Sonja Fritzsche, Beth Judge, and Cara Cilano explained two-fold change. First the experiential learning requirement that includes internships, community engaged learning experience, significant undergraduate research project, study abroad or study away, and service learning. Secondly the cognate requirement has changed from two twelve-credit cognates to one fifteen-credit cognate which frees up 9 elective credits for students with their time to degree. Lastly, there was a discussion about the experiential learning rubric. The committee voiced concerns about students securing internships, and there was a discussion on assistance from the Excel Network and Handshake. Suggestion to make research projects expanded to 'research and creative projects' to give students more opportunities. Changes to AL BA & BFA approved, with the completed formatting suggestions to #7, and the research and creative projects.



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Classical and Ancient Mediterranean Studies MNUN: Adding History 205 and removing History 205a. Changes to CAMS MNUN approved with the completed suggestions to remove James Seaton and Debra Nails names from the list.

Italian & Latin Teaching Moratorium: Required to remove these programs from the catalog since they haven't been offered in 4+ years. Moratoriums approved with the addition of the TE Minor to Italian.

ACM 490 & 491: Independent Study and Special Topics courses added to the ACM code from AL. Changes approved.

Apparel Textile and Design BFA & BA: Presented by Alisa Henriquez on behalf of the ATD faculty. Removal of (FIT) internship in description, will be replaced by a study away experience being developed now, adding a 1-3 credit internship requirement, and removing senior project. ATD package passed voting with the completion of suggested changes to ATD courses.

ATD Courses:

- 231: Removing sophomore & above restriction. Suggestion to remove % from #30.
- 325: Updating prerequisites adding ATD 222, 231 and 323 (or concurrently). Need to fill out #16 learning outcomes.
- 332: Removing prerequisites, changed them to recommended background.
- 335: Adding ATD 121 to prerequisites. Under #24 recommended background, asked them to specify "basic computer knowledge." And in #12 sample source to possibly add a digital source.
- ATD 424: Updating course description. Requesting the course description to align with how the course is actually taught.
- ATD 426: Removing restrictions. Requesting removal of % change on #30.
- ATD 439: Adding recommended background ATD 335. Requesting clarification on if that should also be a prerequisite.

Graphic Design BFA: Subject code change and credit changes from increments of 4 to increments of 3.

Graphic Design MNUN: Minor moving three courses formerly STA subject code to GD subject code.

GD Courses:

- GD 160: Moving STA to GD course code.
- GD 200: Formerly HH200 is now GD200.
- GD 260: Formerly HH260 is now GD260.
- GD 295: New course developed for the entrepreneurship minor. Requesting in #20 the removal of "A comparison is provided in Appendix



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Start with GD 360 at December meeting.
