You have been identified as a Major in the College of Arts and Letters with **Junior standing** (56-87 credits) and a g.p.a. of 3.0 or above. If you will reach senior standing by the following **Fall Semester** you are invited to make application for the John W. Eadie Scholarship in Arts and Letters for International Education. This award is given annually. The amount of the award will depend on the funds available. This scholarship will be awarded each year to an Arts and Letters junior who has most effectively and productively integrated international experiences and studies into your program and career goals. **The scholarship will be credited during the following Fall semester tuition payment process for classes on campus or further study abroad.**

In addition to completing the accompanying scholarship application form students must:

- ❑ write a statement of purpose (**2 PAGES, DOUBLE SPACED, MAXIMUM**) that will focus on the integration of international experiences and studies into your program and career goals,
- ❑ submit a copy of a transcript showing any coursework taken at another college or university. MSU transcripts will be requested through the College of Arts and Letters Office of the Dean;
- ❑ submit 2 (**and only 2**) letters of recommendation, delivered in sealed envelopes that have been signed across the seal by the recommender. At least one letter **must** be written by a College of Arts and Letters faculty member. You should provide your recommenders with a copy of this announcement to assist them in writing letters that will address the scholarship criteria as well as possible. Letters from work supervisors are acceptable **if** the work is related to your education and professional goals and the recommender can discuss your capacity and motivation to achieve those goals;
- ❑ sign and include the provided media release sheet with application materials.
